Boarding Guidelines

If your pet is not eating well, we will supplement it with canned ID food at cost. If your pet is found to have flea/ticks at the time of check in, a dose of preventative will be applied. If your pet should ever develop a medical problem while boarding, such as diarrhea, vomiting, hot spots, etc. it will be necessary to examine, treat and possibly dispense medications for these problems at cost. If a pet with a current medical condition requires additional care, such as bandage changes or maintenance, those will be provided at cost. If a pet requires bathing it will be provided at cost. These services are not included in the standard boarding fees and will be at the discretion of the doctor. Extra-large bedding from home will not be allowed as we are unable to provide the necessary cleaning services for XL items. Cat Carriers will be returned immediately to client, we do not have the storage space.
